BILL IS DRAFTED

Belgrade, Servia.—A bill has been drafted by the ministry of public works providing for a number of railway line extensions in the country. The construction work, which will be carried out by the Franco-Serbian company for industrial undertakings and public works, will include lines from Nis to Morava, costing 15,300,000 francs; from Kraguvar to Prokuplje 10,500,000 francs. The Franco-Serbian company will also, it is understood, provide the necessary funds.

GERMANY'S COAL

WEALTH STATED

Dortmund, Germany.—At a dinner in celebration of the recent jubilee of the Chamber of Commerce in Dortmund, Privy Councillor Klein stated that Germany is the richest European coal country. Her wealth of coal is equal to that of the United States, and only surpassed by that of China.

The latest geological examinations show that the Ruhr district alone has still 400,000,000 tons of coal underground, which is twice as much as the estimated reserve of England's coal. The whole social and economic life of the Rhenish and Westphalian districts is based on the production of coal, and the labor involved in it; the wages paid to miners in 1912 amounted to 570,000,000 marks.
