### GET 9 CROPS IN ONE YEAR

SYSTEM OF IRRIGATION PROFITABLE TO ITALIANS  
Forage Crops Grow in Dry and Gravelly Soil—American Commission on Agricultural Cooperation Make Investigation of Conditions—Network of Canals.

Milan, Italy, June 13.—(Special.)—On a dry and gravelly soil farmers of this district harvest as many as nine forage crops in a single year, according to statements made by agricultural experts to members of the American Commission on Agricultural Cooperation today. The secret of the extreme fertility of this region lies in the system of irrigation, which was shown to the Americans.

In the days when Milan was a powerful independent power, the victories of the Milanese troops were celebrated not by statues, but by the more sensible idea of building canals

or irrigating systems. As a consequence the country about this city is honeycombed with irrigation ditches. About twenty years ago, a plant was erected by the government to carry the sewage of the city into these ditches. From the main canals the sewage charged water is carried through the irrigating ditches into the fields.

This water spreads thinly over the fields and since it has a comparatively high temperature the fields are

**FOR THE STREET.**  
A charming and becoming neck and sleeve finish appears on this street suit of brown. The side seam has been extended into a tab trimmed with buttons and soutache loops. The coat closes with an ornament of braid. The side gores of the skirt round toward the back at the hem where they also are button trimmed. The line of the side gores at the back is similarly extended and trimmed. The hat worn with this is trimmed entirely of ribbon in shades of brown.
