20-TON FISH IS BROUGHT TO N. Y.

New York, June 19.—(Special)—The biggest fish story of the year, if not the biggest since the days of Jonah, has just come to light here with the arrival of a twenty ton inhabitant of southern waters which will shortly be placed on exhibition. It is indeed unique among fish, for it is unknown to science and followers of Isaac Walton who visit this city will soon have an opportunity to attempt to identify this twenty ton monster, the classification of which has so far baffled science. All other stories of big catches shrink into insignificance when compared to that of this 40,000 pound monster, which did not get away, and arrived from the South on a coastwise steamer. The

particulars of the catch, which are thoroughly vouched for, state that it was captured after a thirty-nine hour fight in which five harpoons and 151 bullets were used. It required five days to kill it. It towed a thirty ton yach sometimes as fast as forty-five miles an hour. It is forty-five feet long. It has several thousand teeth. It has no scales, but has hide three inches thick. Other piscatorial exhibits shortly to be put on view include many rare specimens, which have just arrived. By far the most important are the sea elephants and sea leopards, the latter being an extremely rummy fish and particularly vicious when attacked. Of course these two will have to take second place to the nameless leviathan. Altogether the crop of fish stories this year, promises to break all records. Anyone who is able to identify this new fish will be joyfully hailed by local scientists.

Constantinople, June 19.—The new Turkish ministry to succeed the cabinet headed by Sherket Pasha, who was assassinated, has been completed. The new vizier, Prince Said Halim, is also minister of foreign affairs.

REFERENDUM COMES TO AID OF IOLA DOGS

Iola, Kan., June 19.—The referendum has come to the rescue of Iola dogs, and an election will be held here within 30 days to decide whether they shall enjoy the right to run at large in the public streets. Recently

the city commissioners passed an ordinance prohibiting dogs running at large except during the few weeks in the winter. Appeals of owners failing, a mass meeting was held at which a referendum ordinance was drafted, which today is on file with more than 25 per cent of the voters as signers. It is mandatory upon the commissioners to call an election within 30 days.
