WHEAT PRICES ARE 1-2 CENT HIGHER

Chicago Market Closes With an Advance of 3-8c to 1-2c a Bushel Over Monday.
CHICAGO, Ill., Dec. 10.—Closing prices in the wheat market were 3-8c to 1-2c a bushel higher than Monday. December and May showing the greatest rise. Market opened with a loss of 1-8c each for December and May, but was unchanged for the July. Broomhall, Liverpool, cabled that wheat opened lower, influenced by the lower cables. The favorable reports from Australia and later advices from Argentina of good weather with a quiet spot trade, helped the decline.
European visible supply of wheat shows a decrease of 3,934,000 bushels. The foreign crop summary is generally favorable.
