What Next? or Opportunities for Law Enforcement League—by R. C. Bean

An Address Delivered before the League May 8th, by R. C. Bean.

Mr. President, Officers and Gentlemen:

I have been requested to talk to you a few minutes, sticking to the text "What Next?—Or Opportunities for the Law Enforcement League." I do not know to what I owe this compliment. In selecting a subject I think that I might interest you a few minutes in a brief study of the one which has just been announced.

By the word "Opportunity" I am immediately reminded that America has been called the "Home of Opportunity," and its opportunities have been opened peculiarly to all classes, young and old, rich and poor, from the beginning.

But everywhere we hear the cry that the young man of today, at the threshold of life is lost in the crowd, that the old or middle aged man finds it more difficult than ever to make a living that the rich are getting richer while the poor are growing poorer, and the plea for opportunity, opportunity, just a chance, just a chance, is heard on every side.

But indulging as I do in that optimism which is the heritage of youth—it seems to me that the doors of opportunity are wide open in all departments of human effort.

In the matter of commerce the commercial intercourse of men grows every day to a more elaborate complexity; newer meridians of enterprise are fired as if by magic; horizons of more endeavor, more and more limitless, stretch away in the distant and farthest vision; all of which means further, greater, broader opportunity, which is proven by the single wonderful statistical fact that in 1912 the total wealth of this country was estimated at nine billions of dollars, while in 1914 it has grown by the enormous and almost inconceivable figure of one hundred and thirty billions of dollars.

Invention has quickened, whole industries sometimes are revolutionized in an hour by some contrivance or device, the finished product of mechanical ingenuity. An improvement is made and in a few weeks, or months, the world is estimated at nine billions of dollars, while in 1914 it has grown by the enormous and almost inconceivable figure of one hundred and thirty billions of dollars.
