ROSE FESTIVAL WILL END WITH BIG PARADE

ELECTRICAL PAGEANT DEPICTING HISTORICAL EVENTS CLOSING FETE.

Rose Festival Program, Oregon and Portland day, the Festival holiday by special proclamation of R. Albee.

11:30 a. m.—Big daylight parade, in which leading fraternal, industrial, civic, commercial and military forces will participate, General W. E. Finzer grand marshal.

2 p. m.—Grand concert, Rose Festival administration band.

8:45 p. m.—Grand historical electrical pageant, led by 400 members from various tribes of Improved Order of Red Men.

10:30 p. m.—Carnival, revelry and dancing on streets.

11 p. m.—Plaza block, Third and Morrison streets, pow-wow and Indian dances by all the tribes of Improved Order of Red Men.

PORTLAND, Ore., June 12.—Today was a legal holiday in Oregon and thousands of visitors came to Portland to witness the close of the Rose Festival.

An industrial, commercial, fraternal civic and military parade, nearly five miles in length and containing a brilliant array of floral decorated vehicles and car floats and an almost endless vista of marching bodies, was held this morning.

Tonight an electrical pageant consisting of 16 floats, depicting the epochal historical events in the state's history from the coming of the white man to the opening of the Panama canal will traverse the city's principal streets.

The funds will be used to make necessary improvements to the high school building. The bonds will run 20 years and are redeemable after 10 years. Morris Brothers' bid was \$101.
