What are the evidences of this? Well, bank clearings are larger than a year ago, although prices of the commodities exchanged are lower.

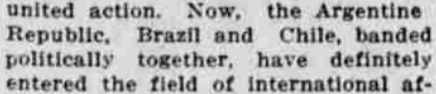

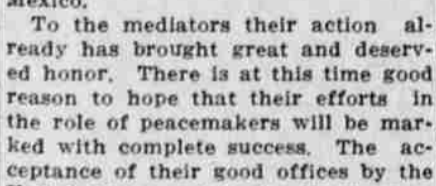
