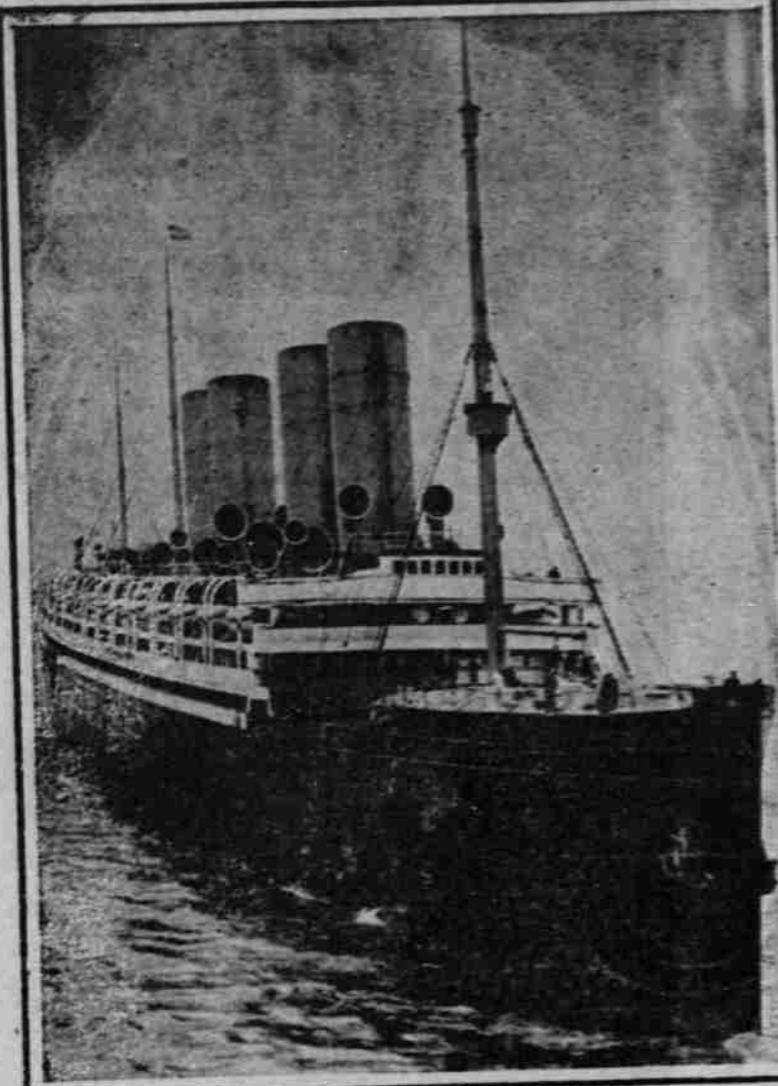

CRACK GERMAN LINER IN COLLISION

The North German Lloyd steamship Kaiser Wilhelm II, which left Southampton Wednesday morning by way of Cherbourg for New York, was in collision in a dense fog later in the day with the steel steamer Incomore, a coaster, and was so badly damaged that her commander ran her back for repairs.

The collision occurred in the English Channel. Thick weather prevailed all day and the fog was very heavy and low off shore. The Kaiser Wilhelm II, bound out and the Incomore, bound in, were following courses that brought them close together soon

after the big passenger vessel got straightened out in the channel.

The Kaiser Wilhelm II is one of the crack vessels of the North German Lloyd. She was built in 1902, and when she was launched held the record for size. Her trial trips showed that she was possessed of remarkable speed, and for some time she had the reputation of being the fastest boat in the transatlantic service. She held the record for east and west bound passages until the Lusitania stole her honors. She is 654 feet long, 72 feet wide and 46 feet deep, and is appointed luxuriously. She registers 19,361 tons gross. Captain R. Dahl is her commander.
