CHICAGO WHEAT HIGHER

Market Opens and Closes Higher With Foreign Cables Somewhat Bullish. CHICAGO, Nov. 19.—The feeling in the wheat market was very strong yesterday with closing prices 1c a bushel above the final figures of Tuesday. Market opened with an advance of 1-2c a bushel for December and 1-4c for the May, and gained strength after a short interval, in which shorts forced the price down. Cables were stronger. Liverpool reported an advance at the start of the session, and there was a sharp advance in the wheat from Buenos Aires.
