## TERMS OF AUSTRIA ARE REJECTED BY ITALY; WAR NEAR

ROME, May 13.—Italy is very close to a formal declaration of war. What was alleged to be Austria's final proposal in the interests of peace has been definitely rejected. In official circles it was declared the government will not keep the world long in suspense and that an important announcement may be made within a day or two.

NEW YORK, May 11.—An ominous indication of the intention of Italy to plunge into the war on the side of the allies was given when representatives of five of the largest Italian steamship lines admitted they were instructed to refuse passage to men, women and children of German, Austrian and Turkish nationality or naturalized Americans of the same birth. FLORENCE, May 13.—Arrangements are completed to turn Florence into a great hospital center in case Italy enters the war. The government has completed a house to house canvass of the town determining what hotels and homes can be placed at the disposal of the nation for hospital use. Women will serve as nurses and replace men on the tramways and as messengers and in other occupations. Many have enrolled for service. Southern Baptist Convention. HOUSTON, May 13.—More than 5000 delegates to the Southern Baptist convention were expected today to be here before the sessions close on the 17th. The convention opened today with fully 2500 delegates from Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Missouri, Arkansas, and other southern states.
