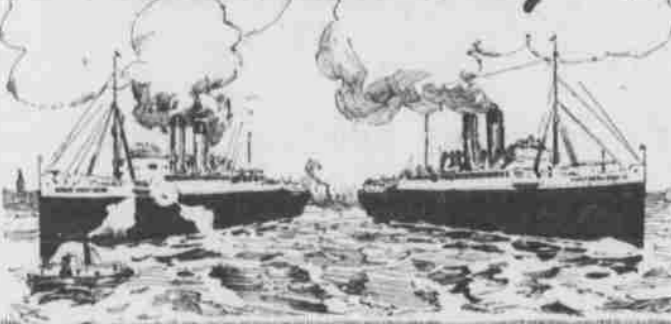

CATTLE MARKET NOT SO GOOD

PORTLAND, Ore.—With the exception of mutton, and veal, which were very scarce, the market for livestock was of most unsatisfactory nature locally during the week. In fact, similar condition is shown at all Pacific northwest points.

While cattle prices showed little change, so far as tops are concerned, a few of these being sold at last week's extreme mark for steers at 17, price performance for most of the offerings was scarcely satisfactory to shippers.

These are naturally two sides to the controversy regarding prevailing values in the Pacific northwest, and both sides are right in certain things. The packing business today is not prosperous along the Pacific coast. Sales of fresh meats are far the small-

est in many years, and it does not take much stock to overfill the wants of the trade. Despite the scarcity of cattle in the country, killers are getting more than their requirements. The overhead expense of conducting a packing house is almost as great during periods of depression as when the trade is brisk. Were wholesalers simply the ones to complain regarding the lack of outlet for fresh meats, there might possibly be some room to doubt the slowness of trade, but retailers have made the same complaint. Naturally, when business is slow the margin of profit on the limited sales must be greater than when the volume is greater, and this possibly accounts in a measure for the extremely low prices offered for the bulk of the cattle supplies.

Eastern Trade Is Different.
To some extent it is really unfair to compare eastern prices for cattle as well as trade conditions with those in effect in the Pacific northwest, because there is practically no similarity existing in the markets for the dressed product. In the middle west and in the east, where the general population has received some benefits from the sales of war materials, general business conditions are much improved. On the other hand, the business structure of the Pacific northwest is founded to a considerable extent upon the lumber industry. While there has been recently signs of some revival in the lumber industry, still the situation is still critical. Lumbering interests and railroad construction work generally call for liberal supplies of meats, and with this demand absent, there is a much curtailed output for supplies.

There is not the slightest doubt that prices for cattle at North Portland are much out of line with those in effect east of the Rockies, but this is scarcely the blame of killers. Supply and demand are the great factors in the market, and just now the supplies are greater than actual requirements of the trade.

Swine Situation Critical.
To some extent a similar situation is shown in the swine trade at all Pacific northwest points. Killers here are holding a big surplus of hog products. Most of this stock cost them far more money than the present basis for hogs; therefore, they are big losers by the present stagnation in the swine trade as are producers themselves.

There was no mistaking the trend of the swine market at North Portland during the week. It was downward. Seemingly there was no help for this condition. Receipts, while much decreased from those of the previous week, were still above the wants of killers, and this naturally forced the general range of value lower, even though a further climb of prices was shown at eastern points.

Mutton Situation Strong.
Mutton market was the only strong feature of the local livestock trade for the week; in fact, it has been the only bullish factor during recent weeks. Receipts are not liberal, and most of the stuff coming forward is of indifferent quality, with the bulk of it purchased direct at country points by local killers. Little stuff has been available for the open market and prices were easily maintained at an advance.
