King Finally Throws Down Gauntlet to the War Party in Greece-Result is Anxiously Awaited.

DATE SET FOR ELECTIONS

December 19 Is Named, a Time Earlier Than Was Expected — If Venizelon Stirs Up the People Against the King, a Revolution May Pollow, Authorities Believe,

LONDON, Nov. 12 .- King Constantine has dissolved the Grecian parliament thereby finally throwing down the gauntlet to the war party. This action evidently followed Vanizelos' refusal to tolerate the Skouloudis ministry with a "benevolently neutral" leader and Zaimis members. In dissolving parliament, the king did deliberately what Venizelos declared he had no power to do inasmuch as Venizelos claimed, the question of what stand the nation should take toward the war was settled six months ago when the country returned him as premier on a pro-war ba-
