### Hog Movement Now Restricted by a Rather Low Price

(Courtesy Sunday's Journal.)

PORTLAND, Ore.—A serious decrease in the marketing of swine and small increases in other lines were features of the local livestock trade for the week.

The big drop in the volume of hogs reaching the North Portland market as compared with the previous six days was due to one of two things:

The holdings of swine available for the trade were either small in the country or else other markets are getting the stock which usually comes here.

There is no mistaking the mind of the livestock shipper. He is loyal to that market only which is loyal to him. In other words the average shipper of hogs doesn't care a rap whether he ships to Portland or to some other market. It's the net return that interests him.

That prices on swine have been far too low all through the Pacific northwest this season as compared with what distant markets have been paying is a certainty. All efforts to dodge the matter would be ineffective. If Portland cannot pay the prices offered for hogs that other markets are offering, then it is a certainty that the hogs will go elsewhere.

**Prices Should Be Equal.**

There should be no reason why hogs should be so low in the Pacific north west and so high elsewhere. It costs more money to produce them here than elsewhere and shippers are entitled to at least proportionate values. It may be that the extreme low prices that have prevailed here for swine were due to conditions unavoidable by the packers. One thing is certain, the business condition has not been of the best. Many men have remained unemployed and these have on normal occasions been the chief consumers of hog meat and hog products. With better industrial conditions and more men employed there is no doubt that the Pacific northwest will again pay as good prices for swine as are obtainable elsewhere.

Killers have been blamed generally for the loss of hog values but the fact remains that the situation in general was beyond their control. Packers cannot afford to rub the hog industry because their own prosperity depends upon the prosperity of the producer. Without hogs a packing plant with its hundreds of thousands of invested capital would be useless.

**Cattle Going East.**

While there was an increase in the volume of cattle marketed at North Portland for the week compared with the previous six days, the better class stuff is no longer coming in this direction. Eastern Oregon is shipping its good stuff to Denver and the east.

The week's market for cattle was rather lifeless. While it is true that \$1.70 was obtained at the start of the week for selected pulp fed steers, this was really no advance in quotations or a bettering of the market. The average run of cattle ruled dull and somewhat weaker for the six days' trading.

**Mutton Market Maintained.**

Real strength is apparent only in the mutton and lamb trade at North Portland. Receipts during the week were slightly in excess of the previous six days in the total amount available for the trade was comparatively limited.

In general the market held strong for all offerings with values maintained around last week's average.

### WOMEN FIGHTING IN CHICAGO'S AMAZING GRAFT REVELATION



CHICAGO, March 3.—The investigation of the charges that Mrs. Pazo, Walter Eaton, until recently superintendent of the bureau of social survey in the Department of Public Welfare, had to pay one-third of her salary to Mrs. Louise Osborne Rowe, head of the department, is attracting unusual interest because it concerns the first important case of alleged grafting among women in a state that has adopted woman suffrage. The charges are being investigated by the city council committee on schools, fire, police and civil service and also by the public service commission. The committee has recommended a grand jury investigation.

Mrs. Eaton, before the council committee, related how Mrs. Rowe had offered her a position, paying \$250 monthly in the department of public welfare, and insisted that she would be obliged to turn over one-third of her salary for Mrs. M. E.
