num of inconvenience to the haulers.  
There is no waste of space in the entire building and this has been secured, too, without any sacrifice of convenience.  
The arched entrance to the building will be one of the most artistic features of the building. The battlement effect of the new Monroe street retaining wall, abutting on the library building on the east, adds to

the artistic effect and the plans of the library board and the residents of the vicinity contemplate the planting of vines to climb up these walls, the sowing of lawn at the foot of the building and the construction of a winding path along the bank of the river. The location of the building is a slightly one and places it in view of all Main street so that the visitor cannot help but be attracted by it and very probably to it.
