(East Oregonian Special.) MILTON-FREEWATER, Ore. April 3 .--- Work has almost been completed deaning off the surplus mud on Main street, and sidewalks, left by the heavy rain two weeks ago. It was necessary to use scrapers to gath er the dirt in convenient plies for wagons to haul away. The mud appears to have absorbed practically all the oil placed on the streets last summer, and it has become so dusty that additional oil or sprinkling will be necessary right away. The surface of the streets which were properly rowned and provided with drainage ditches is unhurt, but where drainage was not provided the mud filled the streets from the crown to the sidewalks, in several places from six inthes to a foot deep which will have o be removed.
