### SON OF WELL KNOWN PIONEER FAMILY OF COUNTY NEAR DEATH

WILLIAM PRESTON PROBABLY FATALY HURT IN CALIFORNIA CITY.

Is brother of Mrs. Jos. N. Scott of Athens; Accident Happens in Santa Ana While He is Riding a Bicycle; In Collision With a Street Bus; Well Known Here.

The Oregon Journal of April 28th carried the following dispatch:

SANTA ANA, Cal., April 27.—William Preston was probably fatally hurt here today when he was run down by a jitney bus. Preston was riding a bicycle. Miss Eva Preston, a sister of the injured man, was run down and killed by a street car two years ago.

William Preston is the oldest son of Mr. and Mrs. L. C. Preston, pioneer settlers and land owners of Umatilla county, now living in California, and a brother of Mrs. Jos. N. Scott of Athens. A letter message to Mrs. Scott states that his injuries while severe, consisting of three broken ribs, broken collarbone and concussion of the brain, are not necessarily fatal and his recovery is fully expected.

Mr. Preston is well known and popular about Helix, Athens and Weston.

### Two Fishermen Fined \$64.

VANCOUVER, Wash., May 1.—About 10 tons of salmon, netting more than \$1000, were confiscated above Washougal, in the Columbia river, by J. P. Huchan, deputy game warden, of Kelso, Wash. The fish had been caught out of season and were being kept with ice to be thrown upon the market May 1, when the season opens.

A. M. Wright and William Stinson owners of the fish, were fined, with costs, \$64 each by Judge R. H. Back of the superior court of Clark county today when they pleaded guilty. P. C. Hill, also arraigned, was released.

### Liquor Causes Strike.

CHICAGO, May 1.—Fourteen hundred employees of the International Harvester company's twine factory here went on strike, according to the leaders, because several workers, alleged to have been intoxicated were sent home by the foreman.

Officials of the company said that not more than 500 men struck. Operations at the factory were suspended.

### New York May Aid Widows.

NEW YORK, April 28.—A municipal movement to provide pensions for widowed mothers with children was begun with the adoption by the board of aldermen of a resolution under which would be appropriated \$300,000 to be placed at the disposal of the child welfare board.

If the resolution is acted on favorably by the board of estimate, the proposed allowances will be granted.

### One Guggenheim Sues Five.

NEW YORK, May 1.—A suit for \$10,000,000 for alleged damages, with William Guggenheim, of the Guggenheim family of copper mine owners as plaintiff, against his five brothers, was argued in the supreme court in Brooklyn. The defendants, Isaac Daniel, Solomon, Morris and Simon Guggenheim, contended through counsel that there was insufficient proof and asked for a judgment under which the action would be dismissed.

### William Guggenheim alleges that his brothers concealed from him certain details about the affairs of the Chile Copper Mining Company and that he suffered a loss to the amount of \$10,000,000.

Justice Bennett reserved decision on the motion made by the defendants.
