#### INFIDELITY CHARGED BY WIFE OF DEACON

NEW YORK, May 12.—Sensational allegations of infidelity were made in a divorce suit filed here by Mrs. Clara Guild, a wealthy Boston woman. Her husband is Dr. Ellis B. Guild, a deacon of Mount Morris Baptist church, and one of the best known Baptists of the east. Mrs. Guild named her husband's vivacious young secretary and Sunday

school scholar, Mrs. Sarah Hastie. She alleged that five detectives recently raided Mrs. Hastie's apartment.
