## NORTHWEST POLE VAULT RECORD BROKEN BY FEE

LOCAL BOY WINS 17 POINTS FOR TEAM IN MEET WITH O. A. C. ATHLETES.

Chester Fee of Pendleton, captain of the University of Oregon track team was yesterday the star performer in the dual Oregon-O. A. C. track and field meet at Eugene. He broke the northwest record in the pole vault, the college record in the javelin throw, took first in the shotput and third in the low hurdles and broad jump, making a total of 17 points for his team.

The following dispatch from Eugene tells of the meet: "By a narrow margin of 11 points Oregon defeated Oregon Agricultural College yesterday afternoon in their annual dual track meet. The final score was 11 to 66.

One northwest and one college record went by the board, both broken by Chester Fee, of the lemon-yellow, and holder of the title of third place, best all-around athlete of the United States. He cleared the pole vault for 12 feet 4 inches, breaking the northwest record of 12 feet 3 1-2 inches, held by Edmunds of the University of Washington.

Later in the meet he heaved the javelin out 173 feet 6 inches, smashing the college javelin record held by "Bill" Nell at 169 feet.

Fee and Multhead tied as high-point winners with 17 points each.

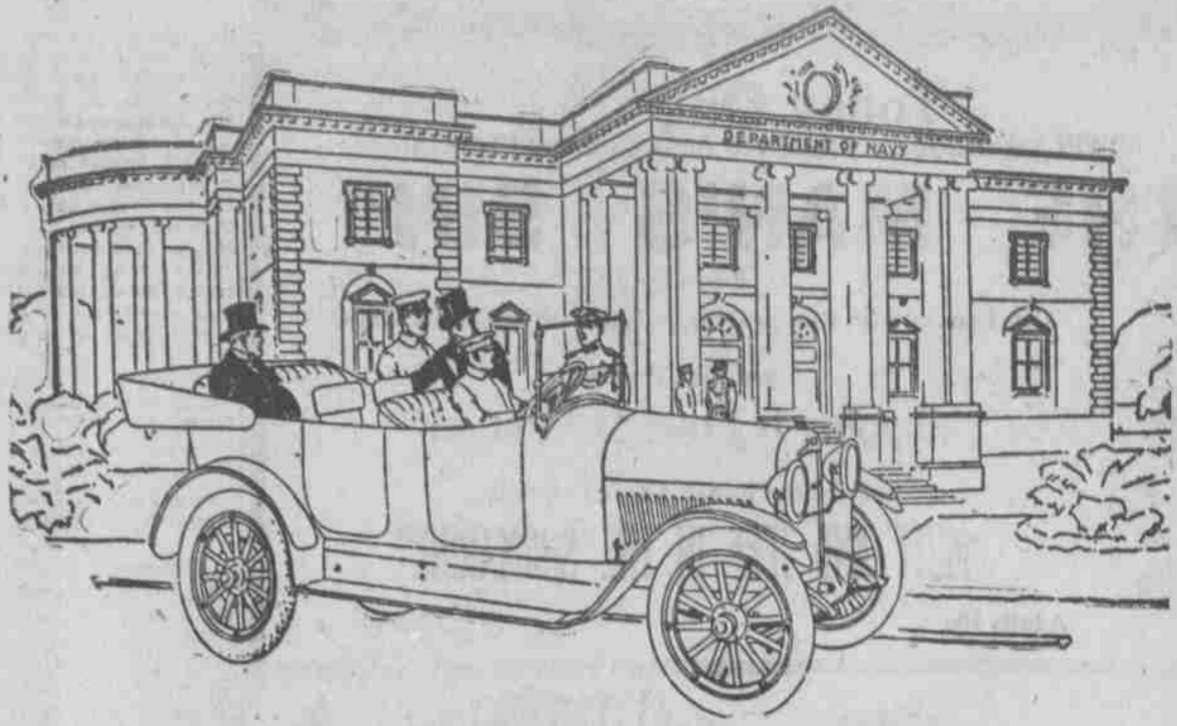

### FOREST NOTES.

In the eleven western states included within the Pacific and Mountain groups, primary power installation from all sources and for all uses has increased 240 per cent from 1903 to 1912, or more than two and a half times as rapidly as in the remainder of the United States.

Primary power installation in the electrical industry in the western states has increased nearly forty-seven per cent in the three years ending 1912.

According to the latest report of the Secretary of Agriculture, 129 public service corporations, out of a total of 1600, claim to own or control a total of 3,653,000 undeveloped water horse power, or 80 per cent of the total water power at present developed and used in public service operations.

A study of mistletoe on the Whittman National Forest in eastern Oregon shows that the deterioration of western larch in the more open and exposed stands, is due to the mistletoe parasite.

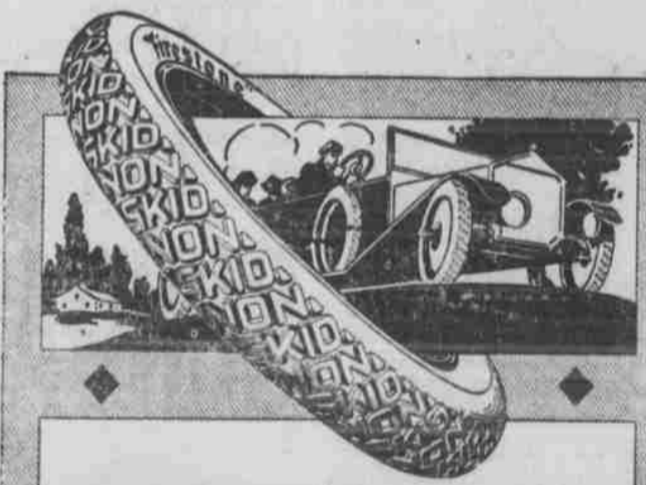
