Big Cereal Orders Reported PORTLAND, Ore., June 22.—Revival of interest is expected in the general cereal trade, and especially for coarse grains, as a result of the movement of troops to the Mexican border. Already there are many inquiries for hay, feed oats and barley, and while no special orders can be confirmed, it is stated that some liberal business has already been quickly passed to the trade for immediate delivery. While there was a slightly weaker feeling during the early trade, wheat on the Chicago market and Liverpool was unchanged to 1d lower for spot, nevertheless the undertone of the trade here is somewhat better. Cereal manufacturers have announced a decline of 25c in rolled oats and oat meal on account of the previous decline in the cereal. Broomhall cabled from Liverpool that wheat was dull and easier on large arrivals and continued pressure of export offers. Spot unchanged to 1d lower, with demand light. Cargo market easy, Manitobas and winters 2 to 4 1-2d lower, with free offers. English country markets weak, 1 to 2s lower. Freight continues weak and flowing quantity large. The decline was partly attributed to a failure in London of fair importance.
