STAR OF THIS PLAY Douglas Fairbanks in "Flirting With Fate," Had Reason to Make the Lady Come to Him and to Forget to Kiss the Girl.

"Gee darn it!" exclaimed Douglas Fairbanks while they were filming his newest picture, "Flirting With Fate," which is to be seen at the Temple today. "I'm sick and tired of seeing these fashion-plate heroes of the screen go through everything as though life held nothing new for them. In this play I'm supposed to be a very nervous man and an inexperienced man. So just to be consistent and different I'm going to skip a few of the details."

"All right, Dougie," answered his director. "Go as far as you like. But if it doesn't look right when you get through you'll have to do it my way." So "Dougie" went ahead and did it his way. He maintained, for instance, that a man who was absolutely unfamiliar with the society ladies, and unaccustomed to wearing a dress suit, both of which conditions described the character of the man he was playing, would not observe the niceties of etiquette with the precision of one brought up in the environment. The rule was that of an artist who is struggling to get along, but who has fallen in love with a rich society girl and has succeeded in meeting her.

Upon being introduced to a lady a society man would walk over to her and be presented; upon being introduced to the idol of his heart Fairbanks, in character as "Augy" Ainsworth, is so nervous that he stands stock still while his smiling friend brings the lady over to him and presents her. Acting on the same basis, Fairbanks forbids to kiss his bride at the wedding scene. He declared he should be too flustered to think of such details.

The director said nothing after Fairbanks had concluded the scenes. But it is significant that he let the Fairbanks versions remain.
