### D. C. ECKLES BUYS BIG TRACT OF TIMBER LAND

300,000,000 Feet Near Austin Acquired by Baker Firm—Plan Large Sawmill for Near Future.

company had taken over 15,000 acres of timber lands near Austin from the Inland Lumber & Timber Company, of Spokane.


There is approximately 300,000,000 feet of yellow timber on the tract. The consideration was not announced. The timber has never been logged and is high-grade and easily accessible. Mr. Eckles was on his way from his home in Ogden, Utah, to Portland to confer with Manager Charles T. Early, general manager of the Oregon Lumber Company, regarding the erection of a mill to take the place of the one that burned September 4. Whether to relocate the mill at Baker or have it near the new tract at Austin will be considered at the conference.

### SCALLOPED OYSTERS.

Stew two dozen oysters gently in their own liquor; add two ounces of flour and two ounces of butter, the grated rind of one lemon, pepper and salt and mix till thick, to which one cup of milk, if there is not much liquor. Simmer ten minutes and then add a half cup of cream.  
Butter well some scallop shells, line with bread crumbs, then a layer of oyster mixture, bread crumbs, oyster mixture, and, lastly, a layer of bread crumbs. Place on top a few pieces of butter; bake till a light brown color.

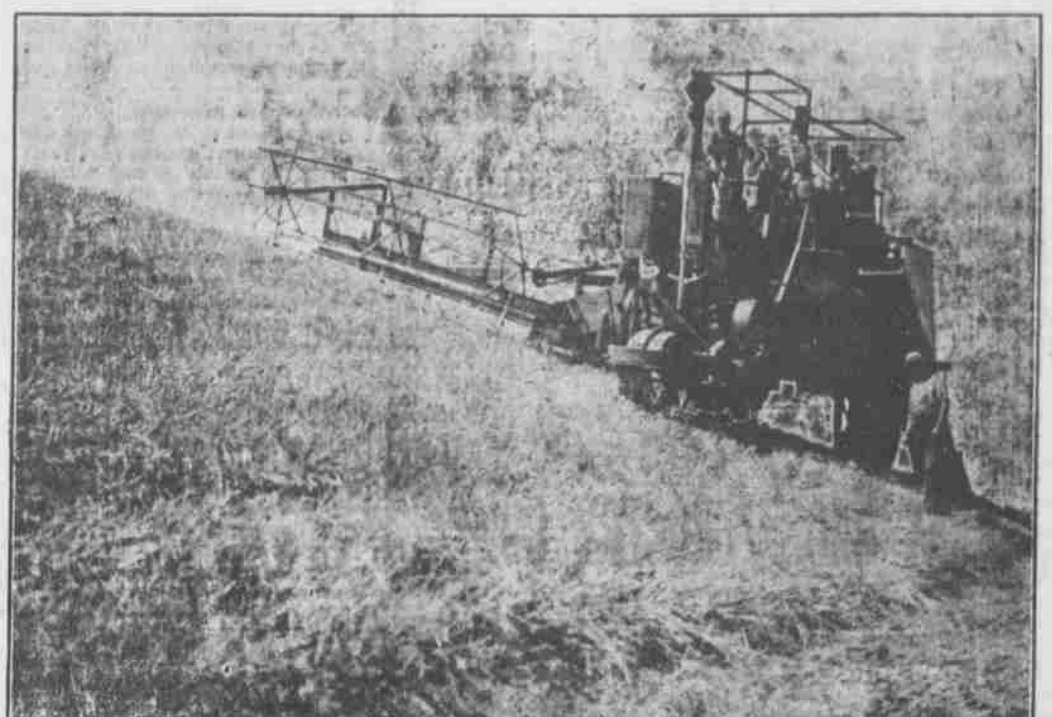

### ARMY GETS MAN 6 FEET 4

Tallest Recruit Enlists on Border and Will Try for West Point.  
SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 19.—There is a soldier six feet and four inches in height at the Presidio here who was said by officers today to be the tallest recruit in the American army and one of the largest men in the government service. He is Roy D. Ulrey, aged 19, and still growing.  
Ulrey has a 48-inch chest, which, with a deep breath he can expand to 45 inches; measures 16 inches around neck, calf and bicep and has a reach with out-stretched arms of 77 inches. He enlisted for service on the Mexican border and has announced his intention of trying for an appointment in the military academy at West Point.
