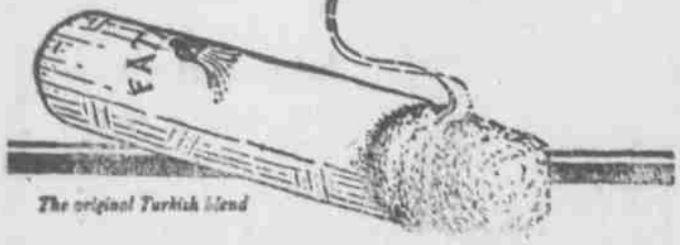

### SALE OF NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER MADE

PORTLAND, Oct. 26.—Assistant District Forester F. E. Ames has today opened bids for the sale of 227,000 feet of timber on the Olympic National Forest, Washington. The Packard Logging company of Seattle were the successful bidders for this timber.

The sale area, which is unsurveyed T 25 N, R 3 W, covers two distinct units. One unit embraces about 2700 acres on the Duckabush watershed and is estimated to contain 110,100,000 feet b. m. of Douglas fir, western cedar, western white pine, western hemlock, amabilis fir and other species (with 50 per cent Douglas fir); and the other embraces about 2200 acres on the Fulton creek watershed and is estimated to contain 116,800,000 feet b. m. of the above species with approximately 75 per cent Douglas fir.

The bid prices were as follows: On Unit I, \$1.25 per M for Douglas fir, \$2.50 per M for western red cedar and western white pine, and 50c per M for western hemlock, amabilis fir and other species; on Unit II, \$1.40 per M for Douglas fir, \$2.10 per M for western red cedar, \$2.50 per M for western white pine, and 50c per M for western hemlock, amabilis fir and other species.

The company is to be allowed ten years in which to cut and remove the timber, and rates to be readjusted every three years.

### HIS HUT A MONEY VAULT.

Safe, Broken Open, Found Buried in Jersey Prisoner's Yard.

NEW YORK, Oct. 26.—Adams Express company detectives working upon the theft of a safe from the Sea-grinch, N. J., station Sept. 18 found much money hidden in the hotel home of Jerome Cottrell outside that town when they arrested him.

Money was found concealed in cracks, jars, cans and mattresses in Cottrell's swamp hut. Buried in the yard was found the 150 pound safe, battered open with an axe. The safe had contained about \$700 and almost all of it was recovered.

So you'll come back next year.

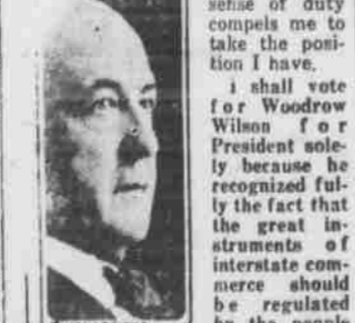
We grow good peaches and apples, too,

### Daily Chats With the Housewife

#### CHICKEN BROTH.

Thoroughly wash in cold water and drain 2 pounds fresh chicken bones; chop very fine; then place in a sauce pan with 2 quarts cold water. Set the pan on the fire. Season with 1-2 teaspoons salt and 1-2 teaspoon white pepper. As soon as it comes to a boil skim off the scum from the surface. Add 1 sliced carrot, 1 sliced onion, 2 sliced leeks, 2 branches celery, 2 branches parsley, 1 bay leaf, 1 clove, and a sprig of thyme. Cover the pan and let gently simmer for 1-2 hours. Skim the fat from the surface, strain it through a cheesecloth. Enough for 6 cups.

#### FISH IN LITTLE CASES.

Boil any delicate white fish; when cold take away all skin and bones, mixing the flesh with salt, butter, pepper and 1 or 2 raw eggs, as you wish. Take some small tinproof cases or ramekin dishes, place in each case some lemon juice with a little melted butter and grated bread crumbs. Bake the cases till the top of the fish is of a golden color.

#### POTATOES AU BEURRE.

Butter, salt, cut with a vegetable cutter into small balls about the size of a marble; put them in a steppan with plenty of butter and a good sprinkling of salt; keep the saucepan covered and shake it occasionally until they are quite done, which will be in about an hour.

#### STUFFED CARROTS.

Take some good-sized carrots; after washing them well and cutting off the green tuft cut each one across about 1-2 inches from the leaves. Scoop out the inside hollow part, leaving a case of the redder part and a piece to form the bottom at the smaller end. Then stew the cases very gently till a little tender, but not quite soft. Take them out of the water, drain them and then, placing each on its small end, fill with hot-shopped mushrooms that have been tossed in butter. Arrange in a circle on a dish and garnish with small sprigs of carrot leaves or brown leaves. Save the inside you have scooped out of carrots for soup flavoring.

#### CHESTNUT AND ORANGE SALAD.

Boil, shell and blanch French chestnuts, 2 cups in all. Chill and cut in pieces, small. Add 1 cup crisp celery hearts, cut in small pieces; carefully mix with two cups of orange cubes. Sprinkle all with two tablespoons lemon juice. Moisten with cream mayonnaise and serve in well bleached chicory leaves; sprinkle with grated orange peel; thoroughly chill and serve.

#### SOME HELPFUL HINTS.

When making starch, try mixing the starch with cold water and pouring this into the boiling water. Boil the usual time, and if used when warm will not need to be strained. If sheets are wrung first by the sel-

#### TO KEEP LIQUIDS.

Grape juice, ginger ale, fruit juice or any kind of liquid of like nature may be kept for any period if laid on its side or placed bottom up. Thus if the liquid covers the cork, the moisture will keep the cork expanded and there will be no room for the air to find its way in and ruin it.

Forbes was placed in the city jail and denied bail.

#### MIDDLE WEST FEARS A SHORTAGE OF COAL SOON.

DULUTH, Minn., Oct. 26.—The prospect of a coal shortage in the northwest is becoming more pronounced, coal men said today. No longer do they expect the supply to fill out the demands of the winter. It will be a case of bringing all coal by rail to the Twin Cities and other points in the interior of the state, they said. This is true of soft and hard coal.

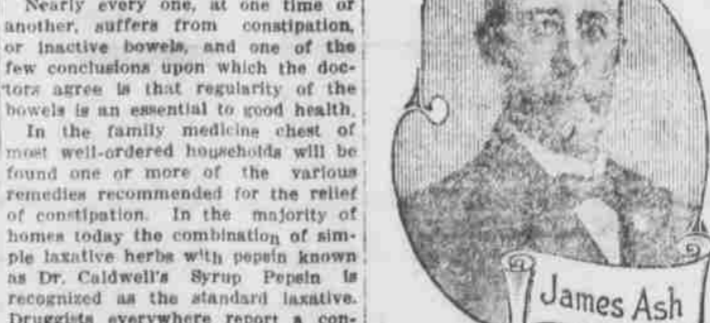
