

Can't machines make cigars quicker than hands?

Yes, but they can't make them as good. Speed in cigar-making is a very dangerous element. Good cigars must be made slowly.

Roll the leaf just a bit too tight and the cigar will not draw freely. Cigars which do not draw freely seldom burn evenly. Often they "gutter" down the side.
