Upon a majority vote of the land owners outside of the limits of an incorporated city or town and upon a majority of the land owners within the limits of the city or town signing a petition for the organization of a district the city or town may be included in the district.

The holders of bonds shall, under the new law, have a Hen on the irrigation works and other property of the irrigation district in addition to the lien on the lands in the district.

Bonds for an irrigation district cate of the clerk of the circuit court showing that the procedure for organization of the district and the procedure for the issuance of bonds has been confirmed by the courts, Bonds may be issued for the payment of interest on any issue of bonds for the first five years after their issuance. This feature is similar to the Idaho statute which has proven very satisfactory and has aided the sale of
