THE SOUTH PLEDGES FOOD PREPAREDNESS

Many signify Willingness to Aid in Preparedness Campaign; Enthusiasm is Wide Spread.

WASHINGTON, D. C., April 21.—Believers in agricultural preparedness are signing in large numbers throughout the south, a pledge binding the signer to do his part to increase the food supply of the country in order to provide for the needs of our army and our allies. The pledge originated at the Memphis conference conducted by Carl Vrooman, the assistant secretary of agriculture. It reads as follows:

"In view of the pressing military necessity of increasing the food production of the south and the nation so as a release food for our army and our allies in our common struggle against Prussian autocracy and militarism, I hereby pledge myself to do my bit as follows:

Reports from the south indicate that the enthusiasm for the work is widespread and that formal meetings and speeches are followed by informal conferences among farmers to settle on some one definite thing to begin on at once. That the south can produce much more food than it has been doing has been for some years a cardinal principle among agricultural leaders but the war has brought this truth home to the people. They are now determined to produce not only enough food for their own wants but a surplus to aid in meeting the situation.

FIVE NEW CRUISERS TO BEAR OLD NAMES

Glory of the Constitution, Constellation, Saratoga, Lexington and Ranger Revived.

WASHINGTON, April 20.—Names famous for a century in American naval history will be revived when the five battle cruisers now being built for the American navy receive their names. They will be named after the Constitution, the Constellation, the Saratoga, the Lexington and the Ranger, famous frigates in the War of 1812.

The old constitution, now laid up as an historical museum at the Boston navy yard, will be designated hereafter as the Old Constitution; the Constellation, now used as a training vessel at Newport, will be called the Old Constellation. The famous ships of the other names are gone.

The present submarine tender will be renamed, and the present cruiser Saratoga will be rechristened City of Rochester. There is no Lexington in the navy now.

TUBERCULOSIS GREAT PERIL

American Physician Finds Disease Widespread in French Army.

NEW YORK, April 20.—Tuberculosis is the greatest disease peril of modern warfare, says Dr. Hermann M. Biggs, state commissioner of health who has just returned from an exhaustive study of the problem in France. Dr. Biggs was sent by the Rockefeller Institute at the invitation of the French government.

Soldiers are not living in the open air in tents, where conditions would be favorable to those with weak lungs, he points out, but in trench dugouts, or are huddled together in villages. He says there are 150,000 cases of tuberculosis in the French army and from 400,000 to 500,000 cases in France.

Armistice Report Not Believed.

WASHINGTON, April 20.—The Russian embassy declared "unbelievable" the report that Germany and Russia had signed an armistice. "We think if such a report were true we would have heard it," said an embassy official. "We have never heard a word about such business and don't believe it."
