NEW YORK VESSEL ARRIVALS GAINING

51 More Reach Port in April Than Previous Month. NEW YORK, May 7.—Fifty-one more vessels entered this port last month than in March, notwithstanding the German submarine menace. The increased tonnage was 26,468, of which 22,470 was represented by seven more ships flying the American flag than during March.

Departures in April were decreased by 12 vessels, of 27,562 tons, as compared with March. Eighteen fewer American ships sailed from here. These represented 49,651 tons. The total number of vessels of all nationalities arriving here last month was 449, of which 121 were American.

The total tonnage was 1,145,749. American, 317,302. In March the number of vessels arriving here was 398, 1,065,212 tons; American, 114, 284, 732 tons. March and April clearances, respectively, were 394 vessels, of 4,827,124 tons, and 282 vessels of 1,025,466 tons. One hundred and twenty-five vessels of 319,972 ton were of American registry in March and 107 vessels of 270,221 tons were of the same registry in April.

Fresno Firmly Held. BERLIN, May 8.—Fresno is held firmly against all British attacks. The war office announced. An additional hundred prisoners have been taken. "At Reus and Bullecourt, British advances were refused," the statement continued. "Between Winterburg and Corbary, fresh French forces attacked after daylight. After three fighting the enemy was driven back partly in a hand-to-hand contest. "Fighting on the Abene and Champagne fronts is less lively."
