# FOR THE LIBRARY

The following is the complete text of the opinion given to District At-torney Keater by Attorney General Brown in regard to the use of city money for the benefit of the county

Salem, Ore., May 19,1917.

Honorable R. I. Kestor. Dist. Atty., Umatilla Co., Pendleton, Oregon.

I have your favor of the 27th ultimo, in which you ask my opinion whether the city council of The City of Pendleton may contract with the county court of Umatilla county to contribute to the support of the public library owned and operated by said county without violating section 9 of Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon and setting out the facts which call forth this question. Said

section of the Constitution reads a follows: nicipal corporation, by a vote of its citizens or otherwise, shall become a stockholder in any joint stock com-pany, corporation or association what-over, or raise money for, or loan its credit to, or in aid of, any such com-Section 4348, Lord's Oregon Laws, which is a part of the public library law of Oregon, reads as follows:

If there exists in any incorporate "If there exists in any incorporated city a secular or nonsectarian library owned and controlled by a society or corporated city city may, when deemed best for the interests of the city, levy the tax hereinbefore provided for, and in hea of supporting and maintaining a public library, enter interests of the city. a contract with such society or cor to a contract with such society or cor-poration for the purpose of providing the inhabitants of such city with the free use of the library upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the council and the society or corporation, and the terms of such contract may give the control and management of the library to such society or corporation, in which event section 4349 shall have no effect, but the other sections there-of shall be considered to be a part of said contract: provided, however, that all money paid to such society of corporation under said contract shall be expended solely for the mainten-ance of the library, and for no other

t is, therefore, evident that the city council has authority to make such contract under the status un-less the same is in violation of the less the same is in violation of the constitutional provision above quoted and in fact they would have such authority independent of the statute, if not prohibited by the Constitution. The Supreme Court of Oregon in the case of Municipal Security Co. vs. liaker County, 39 Ore. 196, at pages 462-7, considered the effect of this Lrovision of the Constitution and its opinion as set forth on said pages is helpful in construing its provisions. Quoting at page 465 from the decision of the Supreme Court of Ohio, as follows:

, but it (the city) canno engage in an enterprise with an in-dividual or corporation for the con-struction or erection of a property which, as a completed whole, is to be wned and controlled in part by the

"We cannot believe that the languge of our constitution hereinbefore noted is susceptible to the conston given to a similar chause by upreme Court of Ohio, nor yield

supreme Courf of Unio, nor yield our consent to the reasons assigned for the decision there rendered."

The court then proceeds to explain that this section of the Constitution was adopted in view of the experience of experience of their states. pulities of other states

taking stock in railroads and other business concerns in order to develop their communities and to avoid the dinastrous results which followed such investments and that it is not intended to prevent a municipality from owning proterty fointly with anyother person, association or corporation, and concludes:
"In the caseat bur, if the relief demanded were granted, the county would not thereby become a stock holder in any joint stock company, corporation, or association whatever; nor would it be raising money for, or loaning its credit to or in aid of, any such company, corporation or assouch company, corporation or asse

such company, corporation or asso-ciation."

It may be added that this was a case where the county had purchased certain real property and issued its warrants therefor, but on account of the constitutional limitation upon county indebtedness such warrants were dectared invalid and the county was sued to compel it to reconvey the undivided interest in such property represented by the unpaid warrants. In the present instance, the city would not become a stockholder in any corporation, joint stock company or association, nor would it be rais-ing money for or loaning its credit to, or in aid of any such company, cur-peration or association, as the words peration or association, as the words are there used. It has authority to maintain a library either as the owner thereof or by contract with another to maintain such library and furnish library facilities to its citizens and in the one furnishing the library facili-ties. It may in fact be an aid to the ties.
