**HOT DRY WEATHER DAMAGING GRAIN**

Reports From Pilot Rock Country Declare Much of Wheat is Badly Burned and Only Hail and Cool Weather Can Save.

Not a little damage has been done during the past two weeks to the grain in some parts of the county, according to reports being brought in to Pendleton, and farmers are generally anxious for rain. The wind of yesterday was a bad one on the grain but just how much damage was done by it will not be known for a few days.

Reports from the Pilot Rock country are to the effect that already much of the grain has been badly burned and that only rains and cool weather can bring good yields. The soil in that country is light and has already dried out. The stands of grain were quite heavy and the land

was unable to sustain them in the face of the hot, dry weather of the past fortnight. Indications of the burning are very apparent in some sections. The same condition is reported from land west of this city.

Another effect the recent hot weather had was to advance the harvest season. The spring season was a month behind schedule and it was not anticipated that harvest would begin even in the light land sections until the latter part of July. However, present indications are that cutting will begin between July 19 and 20. A number of farmers declare they will have barley ready for harvest by the 10th. This rapid maturing of the grain is not regarded as a very good indication for a good crop.

Favorable weather during the next two weeks would do much to bring the crop up to standard. A day like today is very pleasing to all farmers of the county.
