L. W. W. WILL FIGHT TO THE LAST DITCH

GOVERNMENT'S CHARGES CAN NOT POSSIBLY BE PROVEN, DECLARES CHRISTENSEN.

CHICAGO, Oct. 3.—The L. W. W. will fight to the last ditch against the thousands of charges on which their 186 members are indicted. Otto Christensen, chief counsel for the organization, is indicted. Christensen declared the government's charges cannot possibly be proven. He declared, "The L. W. W. at no time has taken any position either for or against war issues. Some strikes the L. W. W. is charged with calling to embarrass the government were initiated before the war started. Most of the 10,000 offenses in the indictment refer to the conscription act. Thousands of L. W. W. have registered and have been conscripted. The charge that German money is backing the organization is ridiculous."

UNCLE SAM AND O. A. C. HELP ERADICATE SMUT

Five Students Appointed to Demonstrate Control Among Farmers at U. S. Expense

CORVALLIS, Oct. 3.—Five young men of the O. A. C. have been appointed by the U. S. Office of Cereal Investigations to help Oregon farmers in the control of smut, the most wasteful enemy of wheat in Oregon. The United States government is co-operating in this movement as part of its plan to increase wheat yield next year, and pays all the expenses of the assistant in the field.

While these young specialists are in the field they will conduct treating demonstrations, hold meetings at which they explain the treatment, and distribute the college directions among the grain growers. The men are now in the field working to reach as many localities as possible in time for the fall planting.

This work will be conducted in co-operation with the county agricultural agents and county councils. Further work will be continued next spring.
