NOTICE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pendleton, Oregon, on the 10th day of October, 1917, the following resolutions were duly adopted:

Whereas, the City Surveyor of the City of Pendleton did on the 21st day of October, 1917, under the direction and by requirement of the Common Council, file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Pendleton, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of the following named street in said city, to-wit:

Calvin street, from the north line of Alta street to the south line of Court street, together with the estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, with a statement of the lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefited by such improvement and the percentage of the total cost of improvement, which each of such lots, parts of lots and parcels of land should pay on account of the benefits to be derived from such improvement, and

Whereas, the Council has examined such plans and specifications and estimates and the estimates therefor, and in accordance with the probable cost of such work and

Whereas, the property recommended by the City Surveyor to be included within the boundaries of the district benefited in the judgment of the Common Council, properly to be included within such improvement district, and no objection thereto has been made, and in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Pendleton, and he it further

Resolved, that the engineer's estimates of the probable cost of such improvement, which said engineer's estimates were made and prepared by Geary Kimbrell, City Surveyor, and were filed with the Recorder of said City on the 21st day of October, 1917, which plans and specifications are particularly referred to, and in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Pendleton, and he it further

Resolved, that the cost of making such improvement shall be a charge and lien upon all lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefited by such improvements and the owners of such lots, parts of lots and parcels of land, so especially benefited by such improvements shall be liable for the payment of the costs thereof, and he it further

Resolved, that an assessment district is hereby created to be known as Assessment District No. 22, to include the property benefited and to be assessed for the payment of such improvement, which assessment district shall include all lots, parts of lots and parcels of land lying and being within the districts bounded and described as follows:

Description of Assessment District No. 22 or Improvement District

Commencing at the N. E. corner of Lot 18, Block 24, Arnold and Haley's Addition to the Town, now City of Pendleton, Oregon, thence S. 66 deg. 24 min. W. 255 feet to a point on the south line of Court street 2 feet easterly from the N. W. corner of Lot 1, Block 25 of said Arnold and Haley's Addition, thence S. 66 deg. 24 min. E. 255 feet to a point on the north line of Alta street 5 feet easterly from the N. W. corner of Lot 5, Block 25, Home Addition to the Town, now City of Pendleton, Oregon, thence S. 66 deg. 24 min. E. 255 feet to the intersection of Lot 5, Block 24, of said Home Addition, thence 25 deg. 16 min. W. 255 feet to the place of beginning.

And he it further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution, together with the notice that the surveyor's estimate of the proportion of the cost of said work to be charged against each lot, part of lot and parcel of land within the assessment district in said Resolution mentioned, is on file in the office of the City Recorder, be published for a period of ten days in said Resolution mentioned, is on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Pendleton.

PORTLAND, Nov. 10.—There was quite a fair supply of cattle offered on the North Portland market during the day. Demand was not brisk, but was generally considered steady. Ordinary to good cows 3.50-4.50. Best heifers 6.50-7.50. Bulls 4.50-6.75. Calves 7.00-8.50. Stocker and feeder steers 4.00-7.25. Swine Prices Unchanged. While there was a rather liberal degree of strength in the swine trade at eastern centers and prices there were generally advanced for the day, practically no change was indicated at North Portland either as regards price or demand.
