At North Portland there was a fair supply reported in over night, most of the arrivals consisting of shipments from the Willamette valley, which came forward in guaranteed prices. General hog market range: Prime light \$15.85@16.80, Prime heavy \$15.75@16.00, Pigs \$13.75@15.00, Bulk \$12.00@13.75. Cattle Situation is Firm. While only a nominal supply of odds and ends appeared in the cattle alleys over night at North Portland, general trend of the trade indicates a continuation of the strong tone shown at the week's opening. No price changes indicated during the day's session.
