

That the Allied Draft Convention

between Great Britain and the United States will intensify rather than re-tard British recruiting in this country is the opinion of Genéral White-head of the British and Canadian Re-cruiting Mission in America. The cruiting Mission in America. "The main point" said General White to-day "is that the British or Canadian subject in this country cannot possi-bly escape liability to service in the war. Instead of being exempt from conscription of any sort, he now be-comes much more liable to service than the American. The age limit for charries. The age extends from 20 to 48. This is a perfectly fair arrangement for it compels every man who chains British citizenship to place himself on practically the same footing as his fellow countrymen at home; and surely citizenship should carry with it obligations as well as advantages. British subjects will, of course, have the same chances of exception on application to the ambasicator as British cities. andor as British citizens have at home. For the first time British cit-izens are placed on a footing of equality the world over, and the Britisher has ample opportunity to serve in the forces of his own country for he will have sixty days after congress passes the necessary legislation to callst in the British or Canadian forces.
