### THE FOOD GAMBLERS' NEW TRIANGLE PLAY

Probably the most timely screen play of the moment is "The Food Gamblers," produced under the supervision of Allan Dwan at the Triangle Studios, which will be shown at the Pastime Theatre today.

Elda Millar, who appeared in "Her Excellency the Governor" has the role of the young Newspaperwoman, who exposes a ring of prominent men engaged in "food gambling." Wilfred Lucas has the role of Henry Haxens, food commissioner.

For more than four years the United States has been represented at the seat of the Belgian government by Brand Whitlock as minister. Mr. Whitlock became famous in this country during the four terms that he served as mayor of Toledo, Ohio, when his broad understanding of civic problems was evidenced in his writings.
