Between 40,000 and 50,000
Head Await Shearing
Crews.

ECHO, Ore., April 12.—Sheep shearing began at the shearing plant, two miles southwest of Echo on Wednesday. As usual, Jake Wattenburger is in charge of the plant and has twenty-eight shearing machines in operation. Between 40,000 and 50,000 head of sheep will be sheared here this season.
