BEST BEEF GOES UP TO PRICE OF \$17.65

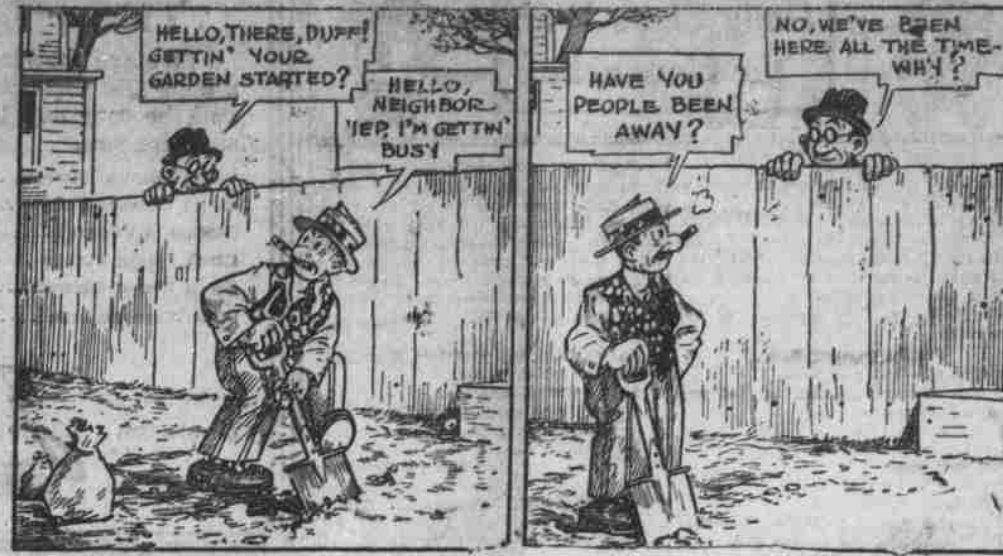
PORTLAND, Ore., April 18.—Beef on the hoof went over the moon and pork prices flew to new dizzy heights at North Portland during the day.
