Cupid's Business Lags.

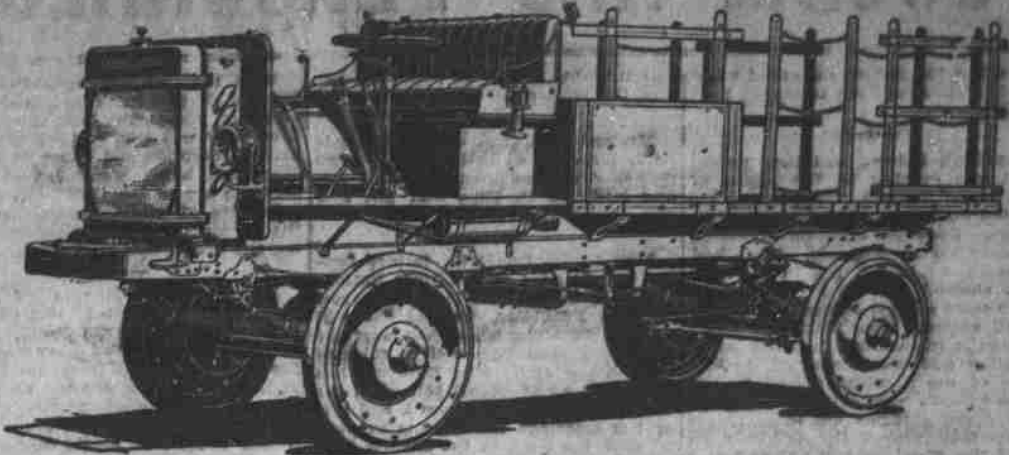

RATING PLAN WILL BE USED IN DRIVE

He constitutes the town meeting of which he is both chairman and clerk, nominating and electing himself to both offices. He must audit his own accounts and present them to the authorities for approval.

ECHO WON WEST END HIGH SCHOOL EVENT

The Echo schools triumphed over the schools of Hermiston and Stanfield yesterday in the west end track and field meet held at Echo. The Echo athletes made a total of 83 points. Stanfield made 56 and Hermiston 55.

The Echo high school boys won their end of the meet handily, winning 42 points against 15 for each of the other two schools. In the grade school events, Stanfield nosed out ahead by a single point, making 41 to 40 each for the other two schools. Lester Hammack of Echo, was the individual star of the meet, winning 23 points for the Echo high school. Lee Ward, also of Echo, was the premier point winner of the grade events, winning 13 points.

Quite a number of the high school athletes entered in the meet yesterday are here today for the county meet. Hammack, however, was unable to come up.

BORGLUM DENIES HE DID ANYTHING WRONG

NEW YORK, May 11.—Gutson Borglum, sculptor, today issued a new statement branding the charges that he was actuated by a desire to benefit himself in his airplane investigation, as a frame-up. He declared the charges made in the senate were intended to discredit him before the people, thus preventing the public from gaining a knowledge of the real conditions existing in the aircraft production program. He declared the "charges of Mix and Mix's engineers were unreserved lies." He asserted that 2000 airplanes might have been en route to France in March. He absolutely denied he was ever "secretly or otherwise" interested in the manufacture of airplanes, or ever offered to use the confidence of the President for personal advantage.

ACTUAL SEIZING OF WHEAT BEGINS

WASHINGTON, May 11.—Actual seizing of wheat hoarded by farmers has begun. State food administrators sponsored by Secretary Hoover are requisitioning grain in several states. The government is paying the regular market price, with minimum expenses deducted. Hoover again warned state officials that every wheat bushel, even that held for seed, must be offered to keep the supply from starving.

EVIDENCE SHOWS I. W. W. DISLOYAL

CHICAGO, May 11.—Excerpts from the "Solidarity" of Chicago and the "Industrial Workers" of Spokane, branded as anti-registration propaganda, were read into record of the I. W. W. trial. These declared the war was for plunder. They said "slaves are as good as fighters or fertilizer" and declared the "war is neither for a principle nor for peace, but for plunder."

The Spokane publication, "Industrial Worker" intimated that Mary Roberts Rhinehart was a substitute victim during a trip through Yellowstone. The party's cook becoming displeased, an illness epidemic followed. Also a "cat" stole the fish caught by the party. "Cat" means I. W. W.

Cabinet Congratulates Commander of Raids

LONDON, May 11.—The war cabinet today congratulated Admiral Keyes, British commander of the Zebruggo and Ostend raids. The blockading of Ostend is referred to as a finishing touch to the gallant achievement at Zebruggo.
