WALLA WALLA, Oct. 12.—Two badly scared Chinamen were the only result of a bold attempt to hold up the Silver Grill, 310 West Main street about 3:00 o'clock Tuesday morning. BRAZILIAN BOYS TRAIN WITH YANKEES

RIO JANEIRO, Oct. 12.—Brazil is planning to send a contingent of 50 or more boys to Camp Daniels, West Palm Beach, Fla., to be trained with American boys of the Junior Naval Reserve of the United States, with the intention of establishing a similar training system for boys. The boys who are trained at Camp Daniels for Brazil will go back to their own country to become petty officers on Brazilian ships. Incidentally, they will help to cement the rapidly growing friendship between the United States and Brazil.

KAN-THE-KAISER KORNER

Do you know—
That sugar can be saved by filling a large sized salt shaker and used instead of a sugar bowl.
That camphor takes out fruit stains without removing color. Try it.

That you can save fat by careful measuring. Use this method: For example, you want 1-4 c. fat. Fill measuring cup 3-4 full of water. Add enough fat to make the water come to the top of the cup, drain and you will find you have an accurate amount of fat.

That you can preserve the life of a vegetable brush by dipping the handle and back of brush in melted paraffin, allowing it to harden before using.

Use Cornmeal.

Cornmeal croquettes — especially good.

1 c. cornmeal.
1 t. salt.
1 t. B. P.
Boiling water.
Sift dry ingredients. Add enough boiling water to make a stiff mixture. Form into croquettes, about one T makes a good sized croquette. Place in a pan of hot fat and fry until a medium brown. Use only enough fat to half cover the croquettes. Drain on a piece of brown paper and serve on a hot dish, with maple syrup. This makes a splendid luncheon dish.

Spoon Bread.

3 c. white cornmeal.
1 t. salt.
1 t. soda.
2 t. B. P.
1-4 c. flour.
2-1/8 c. buttermilk.
1 egg.
2 T. melted fat (substitute).
Scald milk, make a very thin batter. The bread is served from dish in which it is baked and with a spoon.

Southern Pone Bread.

1 pt. sour milk.
2 eggs.
3 T. melted fat (substitute).
1 c. Indian meal.
1 t. soda.
1 t. salt.
Scald milk and add meal gradually, salt and fat. Cool slightly and add eggs well beaten, add soda. Turn into a greased earthen dish and bake in a moderate oven. Cut in pie shape pieces for serving.

Plain Corn Bread.

2 c. cornmeal.
1 T. sugar or 1 T. syrup.
1-2 t. soda.
1 T. melted fat substitute.
Mix the above with 1c butter milk to make a soft dough. Make into small pones, place in a hot greased pan and bake in hot oven.

Southern Corn Bread.

2-4 c. cornmeal.
2-4 c. flour.
1-2 t. soda.
1-1/2 t. salt.
1 T. corn syrup.
3-4 c. sour milk.
2 T. melted fat.
Mix dry ingredients thoroughly, add liquids, beat well. Bake in a shallow, well greased pan for 20 minutes.

Virginia Corn Bread.

1 c. cornmeal.
1 c. boiling water.
1-2 c. flour.
1 egg.
1 t. B. P.
1-2t salt.
1-3 c. grated cheese.
Stir the boiling water into the cornmeal. Add beaten egg and stir in flour, salt and B. P. sifted together. Stir in the grated cheese. Mix quickly and drop by T in a hot greased frying pan.

Fireless Johnny-cake.

1 1-2 c. flour.
2 1-2 c. cornmeal.
1-2 c. corn syrup (the dark can be used).
1-2 t. soda.
1 c. sour milk.
1 c. cold water.
2-4 t. salt.
2 T. melted fat substitute.
Mix dry ingredients, stir in liquid and fat melted. Spread in a greased pan and bake in a moderate oven.

Berkshire Muffins.

1 c. cornmeal.
1 c. flour.
1-2 c. cooked rice.
2-3 c. sour milk.
1 T. melted fat substitute.
1-2 t. salt.
1-2 t. B. P.
2-4 t. soda.
1 egg.
Mix and sift dry ingredients. Add sour milk and cooked rice. Add yolk of egg well beaten and white of egg beaten stiff.

Cook in greased muffin pan in hot oven.

Cornmeal and Raisin Bread.

1 c. cornmeal.
1 T. corn syrup.
1 t. salt.
2 T. melted fat substitute.
1 1-2 c. sour milk.
1-2 c. seeded raisins.
1-2 c. flour.
2-4 t. soda.
1 egg.
Mix dry ingredients, add syrup, milk, fat and well beaten egg. Mix well and bake in a hot greased pan in a moderate oven 20 minutes.

Cornmeal Rolls.

1 1-4 c. flour.
2-4c cornmeal.
2 t. B. P.
2 T. butterine.
1 egg.
1-3 c. milk.
1 t. salt.
1 t. sugar.
Mix and shape as for Parker House rolls.

Sautéed Corn Meal Mash.

1 c. cornmeal.
1 t. salt.
Boiling water.
Make a stiff mush and cook from two to three hours. This is splendid if cooked in fireless cooker. Put in greased bread tin and allow it to cool and harden. Cut in slices and saute in fat. Cheese may be added to the mush for variety.

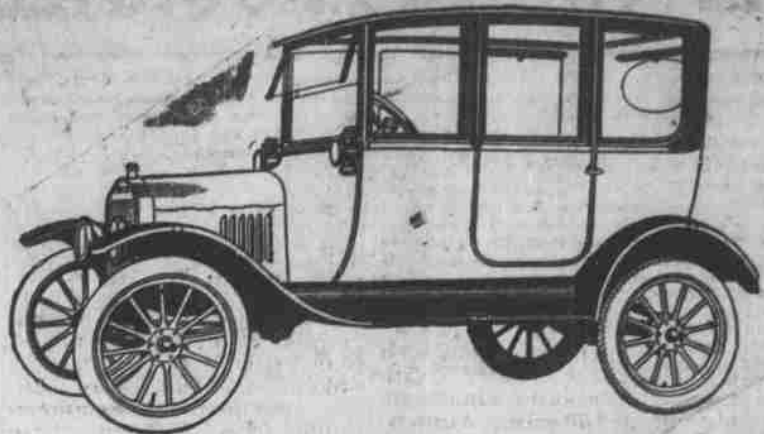
