BLIZZARDS AGAIN CRIPPLE LINE WIRES

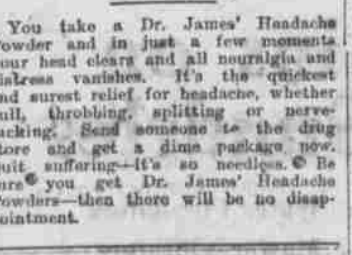
