AMERICAN ARMY HEADQUARTERS IN PARIS, Dec. 21—Plans are under way in the army for the most extensive series of athletic contests ever held. The series is to be terminated in a great interallied military olympic meet. While tentative, the plans have been approved by General Pershing, American commander in chief and the finals of the contests will be held in Paris, if possible.

The plans provide for competitive games, such as track and field sports, shooting matches and the like. The competition will begin by platoons and progress through companies to regiments, brigades, divisions, army corps and to the allied armies.

When completed the program will embrace events for every branch of the service such as competition between machine gun organizations, air artillery, trench mortar and other branches and between platoons and companies of infantry.

The army will be assisted by the athletic trainers of the Y. M. C. A., the Knights of Columbus, and other organizations in rounding out the men for the track and field events. Purely American events will be confined to the American soldiers, but British, Italian, French, Belgian and Italian soldiers some neutral.
