LEGISLATURE NEWS

Passed By Senate.

SALEM, Or., Feb. 12.—The bills

passed by the senate yesterday include:

S. B. 210, by Eberhard—Providing that a parole shall not be granted by the court after the person convicted has taken an appeal to the supreme

court.
S. B. 199, by Smith of Coos—To encourage and protect the oyster industry in Coos county.
S. B. 202, by Handley—Amending the law relating to fishing in the tri-

bularies of Tillamook bay.
S. B. 188, by Moser—Making it a crime to defraud the keeper of an apartment house or a restaurant by not paying lodging or board bill.
S. B. 176, by Porter—Prohibiting a

teacher or any other person from soliciting or receiving donations of money from pupils except as may be authorized by the board of directors.
S. B. 153, by Bell—Relieving banks which receive checks or notes for deposit or collection from liability if the bank on which such check is drawn fails to pay after the receiving banks have used due diligence in attempting to make the collection.

Hard On Joy Riders.
SALEM, Feb. 12.—In spite of the vigorous opposition of Senator Orton, the senate passed senate bill 184, which prohibits the circuit court from granting a parole to a person who is convicted the second or subsequent times for stealing an automobile.
Senator Orton denounced the bill as being the demand of the automobile dealers for the blood of boys who cannot resist the temptation to take a joy ride at the expense of the owners of luxurious cars. He said the boys should be given not only one chance but many chances to try to make good, so long as there was any sign of improvement and in the end the boys generally will straighten up and become worthy citizens.

To Change Ballot.
SALEM, Feb. 12.—The house yesterday afternoon passed by an overwhelming majority Representative Lewis bill providing for the use of a straight Australian ballot in Oregon elections. Smith of Baker, who led the fight against the measure, declared that he suspected the motives back of the measure in which he saw an attempt by a political machine to build up a political party at the expense of the individual candidates.
