HOUSEHOLD

MISCELLANEOUS RECIPES.

Pineapple and Sage Pudding.

Put 1 cup fine sage in saucepan; add 3 cups water; boil and stir until clear and then add the juice of 1 lemon, 1-2 cup of sugar, and 1 cup grated pineapple. Turn out and serve with whipped cream.

Dried Beef on Toast.

Heat dried beef in 2 tablespoons of melted butter. Arrange the tender slices on toast. Mix 1 tablespoon flour and 1 cup of milk with the melted butter. Cook until creamy. Pour over the dried beef. Garnish with minced parsley and hard-boiled egg. Serves four.

Dried Beef With Macaroni.

Cook 1-2 package macaroni in 2 quarts boiling salted water until tender. Drain and rinse with boiling water. Make a cream sauce with a pint hot milk and 1-2 cup flour and combine with macaroni. In a casserole put a layer of the macaroni, then a layer of dried beef, and so on until the macaroni is used up. Put cracker crumbs on top, butter, salt and pepper. Bake until brown.

Lemon Pie.

Blend 1 large tablespoon of flour with 1 cup of white sugar and 1-8 teaspoon of salt. Add the juice and grated rind of 1 large lemon. Mix well. Pour on slowly 1 cup boiling water and stir until smooth. Then add the beaten yolks of 3 eggs. Stir all together, then add the whites which have been beaten to a stiff froth. Pour into a pie plate lined with a rich crust and bake until firm.

Chocolate Cake.

Break 2 eggs into a cup and fill the cup up with milk. In the mixing bowl sift 1 1-2 cups pastry flour and 1 cup of sugar, 2 teaspoons baking powder and a pinch of salt. Afterwards pour in milk and eggs with 5 tablespoons of melted butter. Mix together and beat well. Bake in two Washington pie tins.

Filling—Melt 2 squares of chocolate 1 tablespoon melted butter, 2 cups of sugar and milk.

Scalloped Cheese.

Seven or 8 slices of bread, 1 or 2 eggs, 1-2 pound of cheese, 1 teaspoon salt, a few grains pepper, cup milk. Butter a baking dish and arrange the bread, cut in pieces, and the cheese, in alternate layers, having a layer of bread on the bottom, and one on the top. Beat the eggs, add the salt and pepper and 1 cup of milk. Pour this over the bread and add enough more milk to nearly cover the mixture. Bake in a moderate oven.

LOVE AND HOPE LOST SOLDIER IS A SUICIDE

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 21. — Captain Alex Gustafson, artillery corps, U. S. A., is dead here. He shot himself while brooding over the death of his 20 year old wife. "Since my mate died there is not the slightest hope in the world of being happy again," he wrote his wife, "I realize that love and understanding are all there is in the world," he wrote. Gustafson hails from Chicago.
