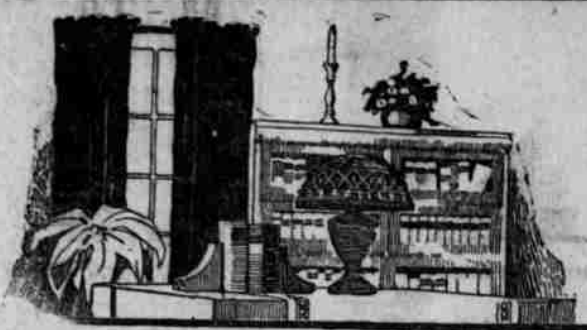

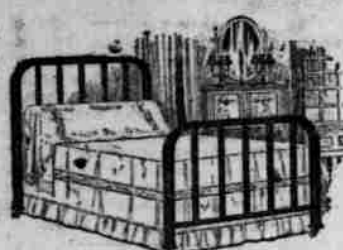

Elusive Kale Comes Back From Travels of Half a Century

More than a quarter of a century old, but looking remarkably fresh for its years, a warrant for \$16.95, issued by W. M. Pierce, then county clerk of Umatilla county, has been received from a local bank by the county treasurer, Grace A. Gilliam. The quaint piece of paper, bearing an early picture of the court house, was dated September 8, 1893 and drawn to the order of Cox, McElroy & Co., an Athens firm.

M. E. Folsom, county treasurer, registered the warrant on December 20, 1893, the reverse shows, and since that time its history and travels are clouded. How the paper eluded county officials for more than a score of years is a mystery, for, like a missing man, seven years is considered the limit of life under such circumstances.
