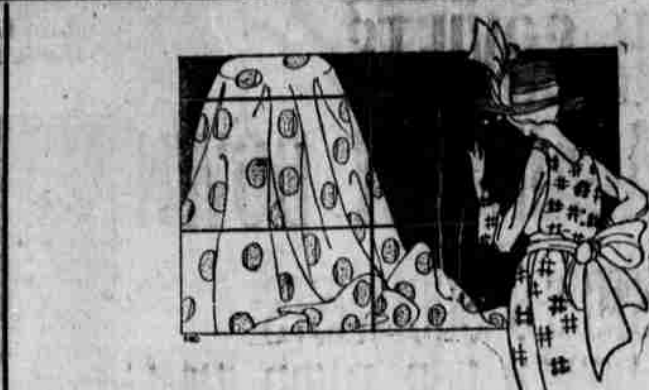

WILL CONFER AGAIN. H. C. L. MAY DROP

WASHINGTON, April 22.—In compliance with President Wilson's cable request, conferences between the industrial board and railroad administration over coal and steel price reductions will be resumed soon. The first conference was scheduled for today but has been postponed due to the illness of representatives of the railroad administration.

The cost of living will take a substantial drop in the near future, members of the industrial board stated, provided agreements on steel prices can be reached with the railroad administration.
It is learned that during the dispute between Hines and Chairman Peck which dragged out over two weeks, informal agreements were reached with some of the largest dealers and manufacturers of food, textiles and shoes—vital factors in the cost of living. Representatives of these industries assured the board of

their willingness to cooperate in the price reduction program.
In some respects the agreement met on steel prices has been made with the railroad.

Big Spokane Plant Sold.

SPOKANE, April 22.—The plant of the Spokane Heat, Light & Power company here, built in 1915 at a cost of \$2,000,000, was sold at receiver's sale here today for \$400,000. P. C. James, a local banker representing eastern interests, purchased the electrical equipment for \$140,000, and E. P. Twohy, an attorney, bought the remainder of the property for \$260,000. The buyers declined to divulge the identity of their clients.
Bonds to the amount of \$1,500,000 and preferred stock amounting to \$700,000 were sold by the company, almost entirely in the east.

MURDER SUSPECT IS HELD.

Alleged Slayer of Karl Liebknecht and Rosa Luxemburg Taken.
BERLIN, April 22.—The Tagesschau says that a man named Runge, accused of the murder of Dr. Karl Liebknecht and Rosa Luxemburg, was arrested recently.
The case, the newspaper asserts, is ready for trial.

Infantry-Cavalry Light Flashed.

CHICAGO, April 22.—Whistles and bells at 12:01 o'clock this morning proclaimed the opening of the victory loan campaign in Chicago and the seventh federal reserve district, as a billion candle power illumination flashed along victory way on Michigan boulevard. The signals started a program of parading, concerts and Mardi Gras stunts scheduled to last until 4 a. m.

ASSASSINS SLAY ALBANIAN CHIEF, PRENK BIL DODA

ROME, April 22.—Prenk Bil Doda, an influential Albanian chief, an advocate of the independence of Albania, has been killed while on his way from Durazzo to Medua, according to a dispatch from Avlona to the Popolo Romano. He met his death when struck by several rifle bullets fired at him from along the road. The assassin, the dispatch says, are believed to be followers of Essad Pasha, the Albanian provisional president.
Prenk Bil Doda was vice president of the provisional government at Durazzo.

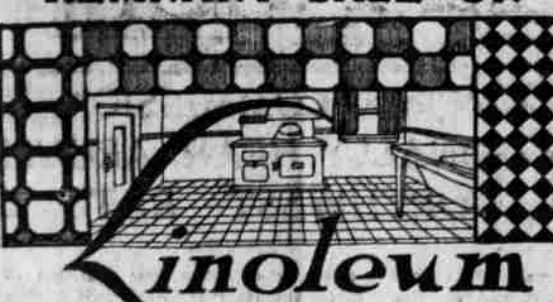
