PORTLAND, Ore., May 21.—With only a handful of stuff reported in the swine alleys at North Portland for the day, there was a generally easier tone apparent in the trade, with the extreme low of \$19 and the bulk stock not quoted above \$19.75 for the season.

While some business was done as high as \$20.25 during the previous 24 hours, the amount of business at that price was nominal as compared with total offerings.
