WINNIPEG STRIKE-FREE IN 24 HOURS IS HOPE

WINNIPEG, June 5.—Despite surface indications of renewed intensity of the general strike here leaders are hopeful of settlement within 24 hours. Authoritative information indicates settlement "with honor to both sides." Secretary Robinson of the general strike committee backed this prediction by telegraphing labor delegates from the entire province to appear here for "settlement of the strike." Bread and milk stations have been

opened by municipal authorities to combat the action of the strikers' committee in calling out all milk wagon drivers, bakers and other provisions workers. City officials said today they would enlist the aid of returned soldiers to fight the strikers by driving wagons and operating the stations.

Plan Being Revised.

A tentative plan for settlement "with honor to both sides" prepared by the Railroad Brotherhood mediation board, was presented today for review by all factions. It is learned on good authority.

The iron workers dispute which precipitated the general walkout has been settled it was stated and is only waiting the signatures of metal workers leaders and iron masters. According to general agreement all strikers are to be taken back without discrimination. Provisions have been made for signing a pact agreeing to the collective bargaining principle. In return for these concessions it is reported, the strikers will call off the sympathetic strike. If the finding of the commission are upheld they may form a basis for calling off all the sympathetic strikes in various Canadian cities.

DUDLEY M. STORRS IS ON TRIAL TODAY

OKANOGAN, Wash., June 5.—(By United Press.)—Dudley M. Storrs was placed on trial here today on a charge of seduction and for a statutory offense involving Ruth Garrison.

Miss Garrison was sent to the ward of the criminal insane at Walla Walla penitentiary after being acquitted, recently by a jury for murdering Storrs' wife, on the grounds of mental irresponsibility. The girl, during the trial, testified that she had lived with Storrs previous to the time she poisoned Mrs. Storrs. The Garrison girl was brought here yesterday from Walla Walla to testify for both the defense and the state.
