ment purposes. It is still so used, but in a modern way.

Five French men cooks prepare the noon luncheon and evening dinner. Three American men cooks get breakfast for the reason that we desire and love hotcakes, oatmeal, real American stuff about which no French cook knows anything unless he has cooked in America. There are 22 French women and girls on the different lines of work, besides these we have American Sergeants over each department of the institution. One over the kitchen, one making the hot drinks, another over the bread and butter and milk, still another over the buying of the material, one interpreter, a driver and his helper, two doing police or sanitary work. We have had four American "Y" girls behind the counter to serve the different dishes as the line files past.

They have to be drawn from the entertainment department here in Le

Mons and are mostly from the so called "dancing girls" who were brought here to help entertain the A. E. F. at dancing functions. Of course they are up late most of the time and can't always be present when needed, so we will likely have to fall back on some of the French girls who are splendid workers and very dependable. It is my special duty to see that each and every department in this big establishment functions, and that too, on time. For there are each day long lines at 7:00 to 9:00 a. m.; 11:20 to 1:30 p. m.; 6:15 to 7:15 p. m. of hungry American soldiers waiting to be fed. The number each meal ranges respectively about, 300 for breakfast, 500 for noon luncheon, 700 for evening dinner. These numbers will grow for certain, the reason is this. The business committee just came in from Paris today telling us that they were here to consult Le Mons area business committee relative to converting a large room we have for sleeping quarters for about 100 men in cheap cots, into an ice cream factory. Then, if that goes through, watch the

numbers in our line jump. They are already on an increase as the weather gets better. It was Napoleon or some other wise guy that said something about an army going forward on its stomach or not being able to fight on an empty stomach. If the army that we feed each day went forward on fought according to the condition of their stomachs when they leave this cafeteria, oh lady, I would hate to be an enemy in front of them. The buying sergeant and I go out with "beaucoup" francs. The Ford comeonette returns groaning under the loads, minus francs.

So far, I have enjoyed this semi-new line of work, I say, not altogether new line of work, for I have been manager of 27th "Y" Division mess practically ever since I have been in France till recently and while the 27th and 20th divisions were wrecking old Hindenburg's line, I had all the cooking for the "Y" division headquarters. I will enjoy it more and will do all in my power to put it across.

ROBERT BURNS DIES IN WALLA WALLA

WALLA WALLA, June 7.—Robert Burns, for years general agent for the Harriman lines in the Walla Walla territory, dropped dead in Smalley's drug store about 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon from heart trouble.

Mr. Burns stepped into the drug store a few minutes before and while waiting to be served by one of the clerks paced up and down the aisle. Mr. Ryan, pharmacist at the store, stopped for a moment and engaged Mr. Burns in conversation. Mr. Ryan asked whether or not Mr. Burns intended to return to the Harriman lines after the government relinquished control of the railroads.

Mr. Burns remarked he did not think so and in answer to a question as to what had become of Miss Barker, his assistant, he replied she was still in charge of the city office. Hardly a second later Mr. Burns remarked, "I am so sick" and started to fall. Mr. Ryan called to a clerk standing close by to catch Mr. Burns and Nels Peterson, circulation solicitor for the Morning Union, who was standing close by, caught Mr. Burns as he sank to the floor unconscious.

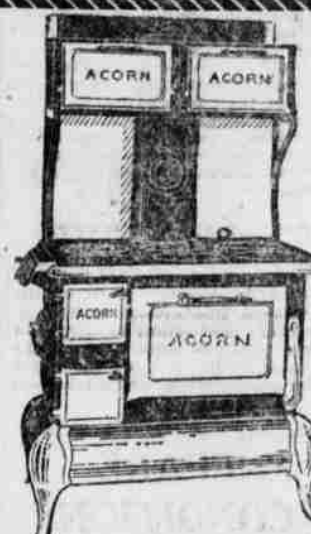
