Put four tablespoons of butter into a saucepan; add one cup of water; add quickly a cup of sifted flour, a pinch of salt, and one tablespoonful of sugar, stir well until the mixture leaves the sides of the pan. Remove from the fire, allow to cool, but not to become cold; add four eggs, beating each one thoroughly in. Set away in a cool place for one hour, put into a frying-dish with a plain tube and fry in a pan of smoking hot fat, fry for five minutes, then drain on

paper, and sift with powdered sugar.

Clam Bouillon.
Chop 1 pint of clams very fine, add two cupsful of water and the clam liquor to these, with a bay leaf, sprig of parsley and a slice of onion. Simmer 10 minutes, strain through a cloth, dilute if necessary and serve with or without whipped cream.

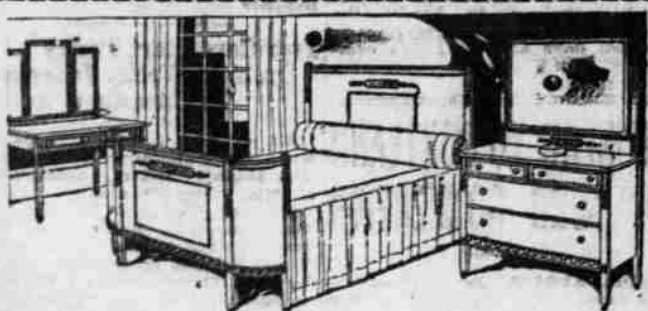
