SPRUCE HOLDINGS TO BE OFFERED FOR SALE

(By United Press.)

PORTLAND, June 12.—The United States Spruce Production corporation announced today that its sawmills, logging railroads and timber holdings in Oregon and Washington, are to be

offered for sale to commercial lumber operators.

The holdings of the Spruce Production corporation in the two states are worth several millions of dollars. Bids for the purchase of the various properties will be received at the corporation's offices in Portland until September 2 at noon.

Today's announcement clears up the speculation in the minds of lumber producers in regard to the disposition of these properties, which were developed by the government last year to assume the continuous large scale production of fir and spruce aircraft lumber.

Since these properties were planned for the government by experienced loggers and lumbermen, with a view of having them rapidly adaptable to commercial lumber production when the emergency demand for aircraft lumber had ceased, there has already been considerable interest manifested by lumbermen contemplating operations in the Pacific northwest. These lumbermen realize the possibilities of getting into immediate operation the projects developed by the government. This being able to meet the present high pressure demand for lumber. At the time of the signing of the

armistice, the government had completed 75 miles of main line railroad, feet of lumber. A tract of timber in spruce, hemlock and cedar, with a like mileage of spur, graded Lincoln county, Oregon, amounted to and partly constructed into the timber more than 12,500 acres and containing about 500,000,000 feet of fir, airplane stock, is among the properties

two sawmills with a total cutting capacity, in eight hours, of 650,000 board feet for which bids will be called on September 2.

The larger sawmill, with a 400,000 cutting feet capacity, is located at Port Angeles, Washington, and the larger part of the railroad development has been cause of its high quality for cutting

developed to a point where production can be had in from 60 to 90 days.

"Our mills, with the most extensive hitherto undeveloped timber areas adjacent to them, and with their excellent water and rail transportation facilities—enjoying Pacific coast terminal freight rates—will be a considerable factor in meeting the present unprecedented demand for lumber as soon as they are turned into private hands and the machinery is started in production."

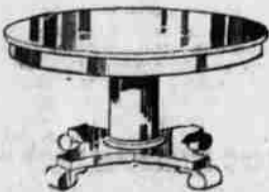

Dining Table

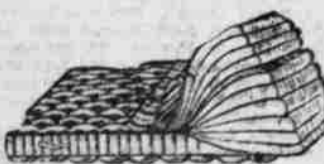
THAT OPENS TO 6 FT. NO MORE WIGGLE—NO MORE GIGGLE!
