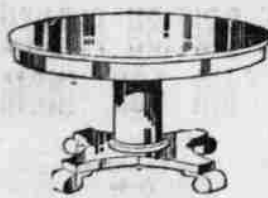

Dining Table

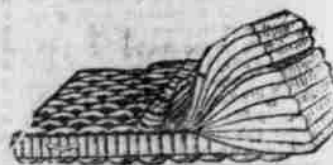
THAT OPENS TO 6 FT.
