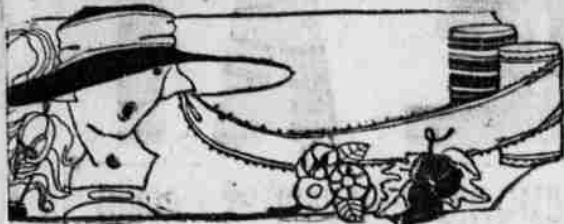

FOE MINISTER SAYS CROPS ABOVE AVERAGE

Necessity of Importing Meat
No More Important
Than Grain.

BERLIN, June 25.—The crops in Germany this season were better than the average, but they have been checked by the bad weather which prevailed in May, and they will be still further affected if a rainless season should set in, said Herr Schmidt, the Food Minister, in an interview yesterday.

"The quality of the wheat also has been affected unfavorably by lack of fertilizer," Germany anticipates, however, that she will be able to continue her present bread ration, which, the very small, will do in a pinch with the expected German grain harvest.

The minister added that he hoped there would be continued assistance for Germany from abroad so that the bread-hungry population might have at least a small increase in their ration, and above all that they might continue to enjoy splendid white bread made from American wheat. He said he estimated that a million and a half tons of wheat would be needed in addition to the home harvest.

according to the Food Minister, is now more important than grain.

ST. LOUIS AVIATOR DENIES HE WON D. C. AND FRENCH CROSS

NEW YORK, June 24.—Lieut. Kendall E. Hopkins son of George E. Hopkins, 244 Belmont boulevard, a member of the First Pursuit Group, formerly commanded by Capt. Eddie Rickenbacker, American "ace of aces," is spending a leave of absence with his parents preparatory to reporting at Camp Grant for his discharge.

He said that a statement given out in New York, when the squadron arrived in the United States June 1, that he had been awarded the D. C. and Croix de Guerre, was a mistake. He said he believed the mistake was due to the fact that the Ninety-fourth Squadron had received citations from the French which entitled the group to the Croix de Guerre with palm. The squadron has been officially credited with downing 70 enemy planes and unofficially with 42 others.

The Ninety-fourth was the only air squadron which went to Coblenz with the American army of occupation. The total casualties in the squadron were 10 killed, 5 wounded and three taken prisoners.

Man's Five Suits Gives Spokane Police a Clew

SPOKANE, June 25.—Wearing five complete suits of clothes and a heavy

overcoat, with the pockets of each garment filled with a varied assortment of alleged seven pointer, Paul C. Johnson, age 43, an orange picker, was arrested on a charge of vagrancy last night at Post street and First avenue by Patrolman Hudson. In addition Johnson was carrying a sack filled with everything from a dozen suits to silver knives and forks.

Johnson had carefully donned each suit on top of the other, including coat, vest and trousers. His bulky appearance aroused the suspicions of Officer Hudson.

Hidden in the lining of the inside suit the police found a complete set of steel saws used for making jail breaks.

Johnson's bond was set at \$500 and a further investigation will be made as to the ownership of the articles found in his many pockets.

Hair Struck Through Hat, Says Bear Story

JUNEAU, Ala., June 25.—The first bear story of the season has arrived. A man living on the trail near Donnelly recently went out to get a load of wood, and came face to face with a big brown bear.

The bear struck at the man, the wind from the blow tearing off his shirt. His partner had to clip his hair to get his hat off, as it had stood up so straight the hairs had stuck thru and clinched.
